Where?

Living Beyond will take place at the Woodcroft Centre near Chepstow. Accommodation will be in single sex shared rooms of up to six people.

In order to save you money, bedding is not included in the price, and therefore you will need to provide your own sheets, duvet cover and pillow cases.

How much?

We have tried to keep the costs for Living Beyond as low as possible. To make it easier, we have introduced three price tiers. The earlier you book, the greater the saving.

Super Early Bird £65 Book by 4th June 23

Early Bird £70 Book by 25th July 2023

Regular: £75 Book from 26th July 2023

The cost includes food, accommodation and activities.

Where finance is a real challenge for you, we would request you contact your local Youth for Christ Centre in confidence, to discuss how we can help. We would not want a young person to miss out on finance alone. We will work with you to see how this can be overcome.

FAQs

Do I need to come with a leader?

No, this residential is different to our other residentials. Youth for Christ will provide the leaders to run the residential. You can come as an individual or as part of a group, but you do not need a leader.

What age range is the weekend for?

You need to be in school years 7-13 in October 2023.

What if I don't know anyone else?

Don't worry, we will ensure you still have a great time and you will get to know lots of new friends.

I am a new Christian, can I still come?

Anyone can come to Living Beyond, but it is aimed at those young people who want to go deeper with their faith. This means it will be different to our Big Weekender. There will be less games, more worship, teaching and discussion; although we will still have fun.
